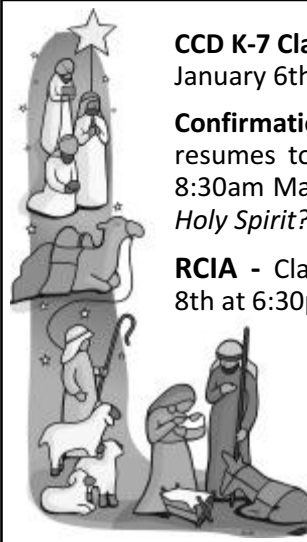

## Can Christmas Be Saved?

Ever since November 1st, Christmas songs have been playing on radio stations non-stop. What appears even worse, stores of all sizes have been reminding us to do our Christmas shopping since September! All these messages to get us out shopping at the Malls or to do our online Christmas Shopping; because if you do, you might get free shipping! If that is not a strong enough endorsement, there were extra incentives of large discounts. All if you start spending money as early as possible.



Sadly our culture and society say, Christmas ends on December 26. Take those Christmas trees down, take the outdoor lights off the bushes and store everything away for next year. Remember Christmas will be coming even before our students have returned from Summer Vacation. In spite of all this, we in the Church fight the battle of teaching that the Christmas Season doesn't really begin until Christmas Day.

Today, as we celebrate the Liturgical Feast of Epiphany, we need to remember that of all days today is the day to give gifts. Here are how other countries celebrate the arrival of the Three Kings acknowledging the Christ Child:

In Portugal, people take part in Epiphany carol singing  
In France you might eat a 'Galette des Rois', a type of flat almond cake.  
In Mexico where Epiphany is known as 'El Dia de los Reyes' (the day of The Three Kings). It's traditional to eat a special cake called 'Rosca de Reyes' (Three Kings Cake). A figure of Baby Jesus is hidden inside the cake. Whoever has the baby Jesus in their piece of cake is the 'Godparent' of Jesus for that year.  
In Italy, some children also get their presents on Epiphany.  
In Austria, at Epiphany, some people write a special sign in chalk over their front door. It's a reminder of the Wise Men that visited the baby Jesus.  
In Belgium, children dress up as the three wise men and go from door to door to sing songs.  
In Ireland, Epiphany is also sometimes called 'Nollaig Nam Bean' or Women's Christmas. Traditionally the women get the day off and men do the housework and cooking!
